

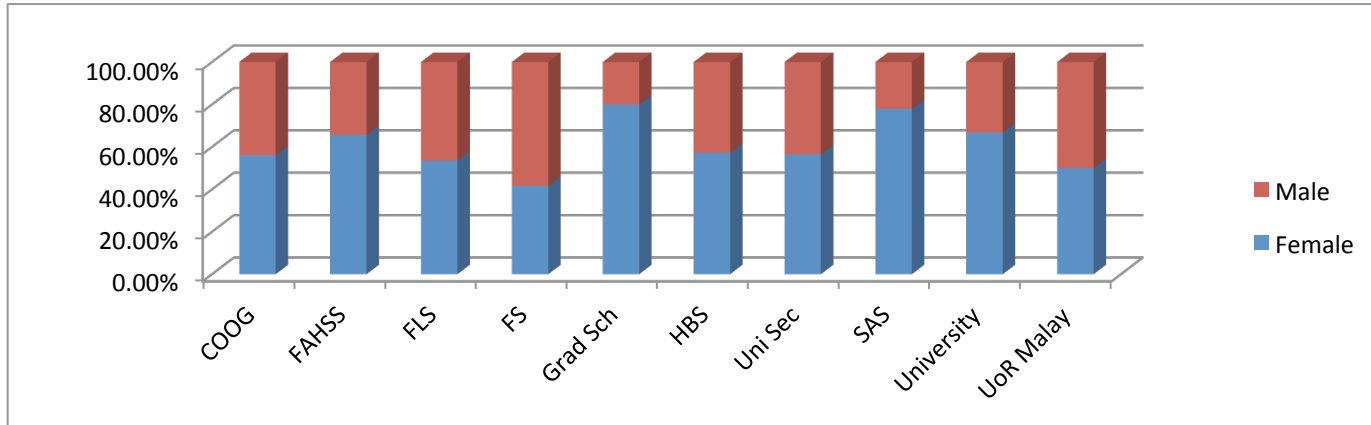

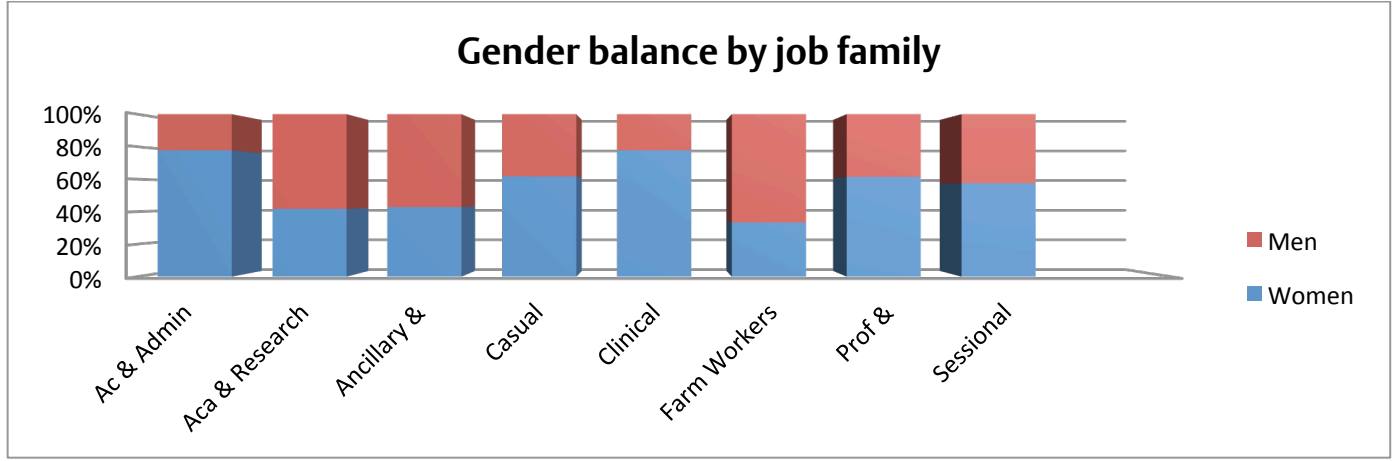

## Gender

The majority of staff at the University are women. The only area where there are more men than women is in the Faculty of Science.



Women account for a greater proportion staff working in academic and administrative support, casual, sessional, and professional and managerial roles. This is broadly comparable with the sector averages as seen in the ECU *Equality in higher education: statistical report 2012*. They are less represented in Academic and Research and Ancillary and Operational roles.

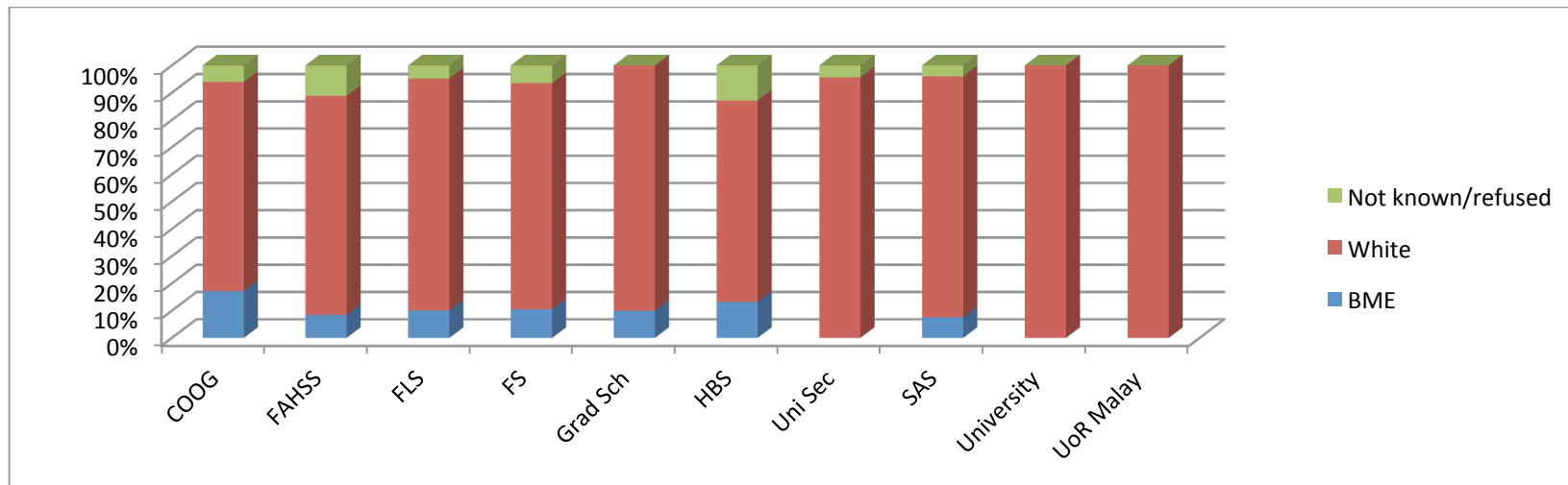


As a result, when viewed by grade women are in the majority in nearly every grade (with the exception of Grade 2 which has a greater proportion of ancillary and operational roles) until Grade 8, where after there is a steady decline in their representation.

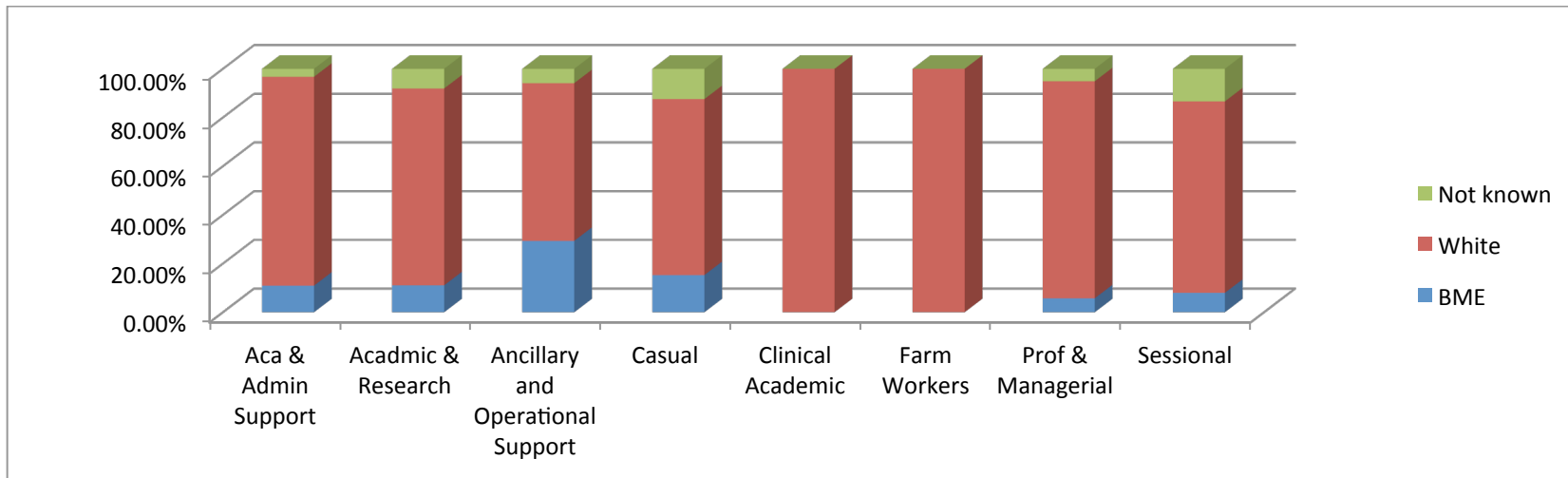

## Ethnicity

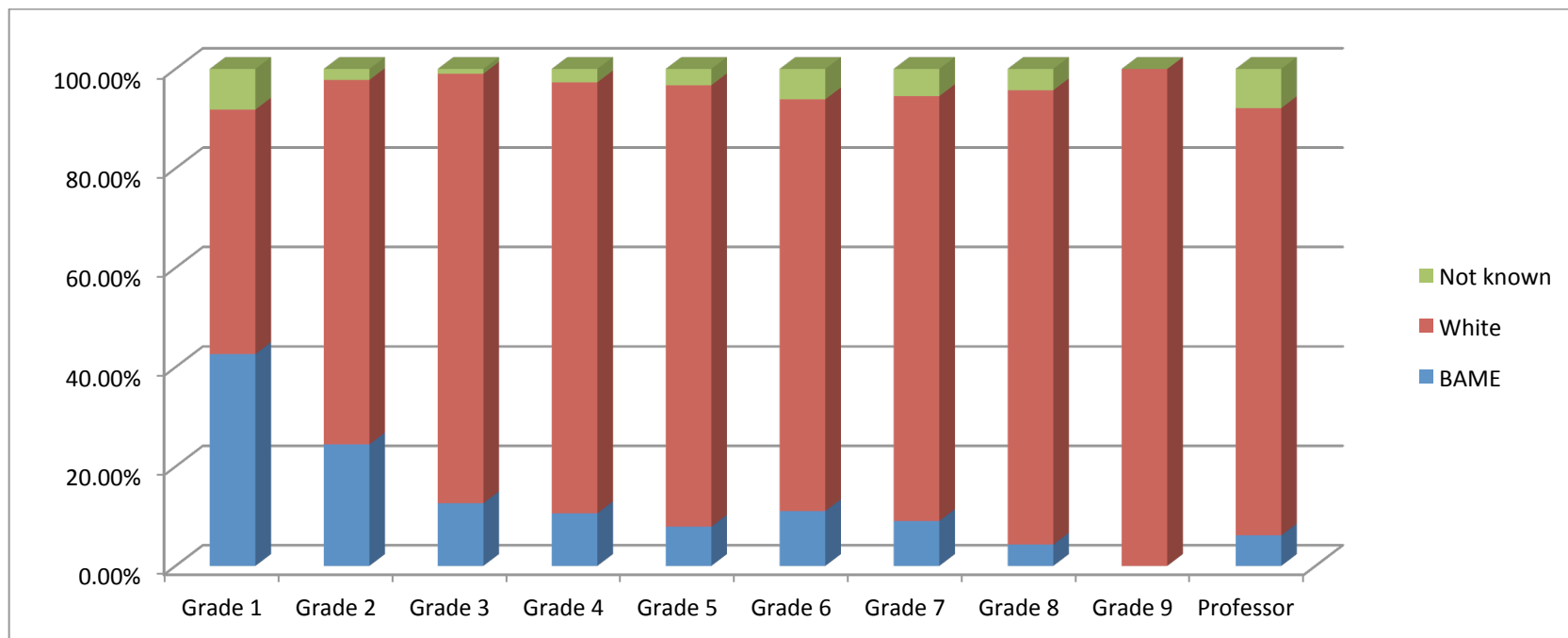
Whilst almost 11.54% of the total University population is Black, Asian, and Minority Ethnic there are significant variations across the Faculties and Services, with the greatest proportions being found in the Chief Operating Officers Group and the Henley Business School. Student & Academic Services has the lowest proportion of BAME staff, significantly lower than the 11% for the whole University at just 7.54%.



When viewed by job family it becomes apparent that the greatest proportion of BAME staff are working in Ancillary and Operational roles (29%), followed by Casual roles (15%). The proportion working in Professional and Managerial roles is far lower at 6%.



When viewed by grade, there is a peak of BAME staff in Grade 1 (42.6%) which steadily declines until a further peak in Grade 6 (11.04%), before a drop at Grade 9 where there are no BAME staff, and only 6% of Professors.



Within the job families the variation of ethnicity suggests that Black and Asian British staff are represented less in the higher grades at the University:

- Within the Academic and Administrative Support job family the largest ethnic group is white British (77.38%) followed by other white background (7.76%), Black British (1.53%), Asian British (3.28%) and Chinese (1.75%);
- The Ancillary and Operational Support staff are more diverse with White British (57.46%) in the majority but greater representation from those with an Other Asian Background (11.98%), Other White Background (6.85%), Black British (6.6%), and Asian British (6.11%) background;

- Amongst Academic and Research staff, White British is less predominant (54.25%) reflecting the broader number of European staff as “Other White Background” represents a quarter of the population (25.18%). This is followed by Chinese (3.28%) and Asian British - Indian (2.45%), with notably low representation amongst Black British staff (0.82% or 8 individuals); and
- The Professional and Managerial job family is predominantly White British (80.92%), with the next highest ethnicity being White Other (6.67%). There are low levels of representation from Asian British (1.44%), Chinese (1.7%), Black British (0.78%) staff.

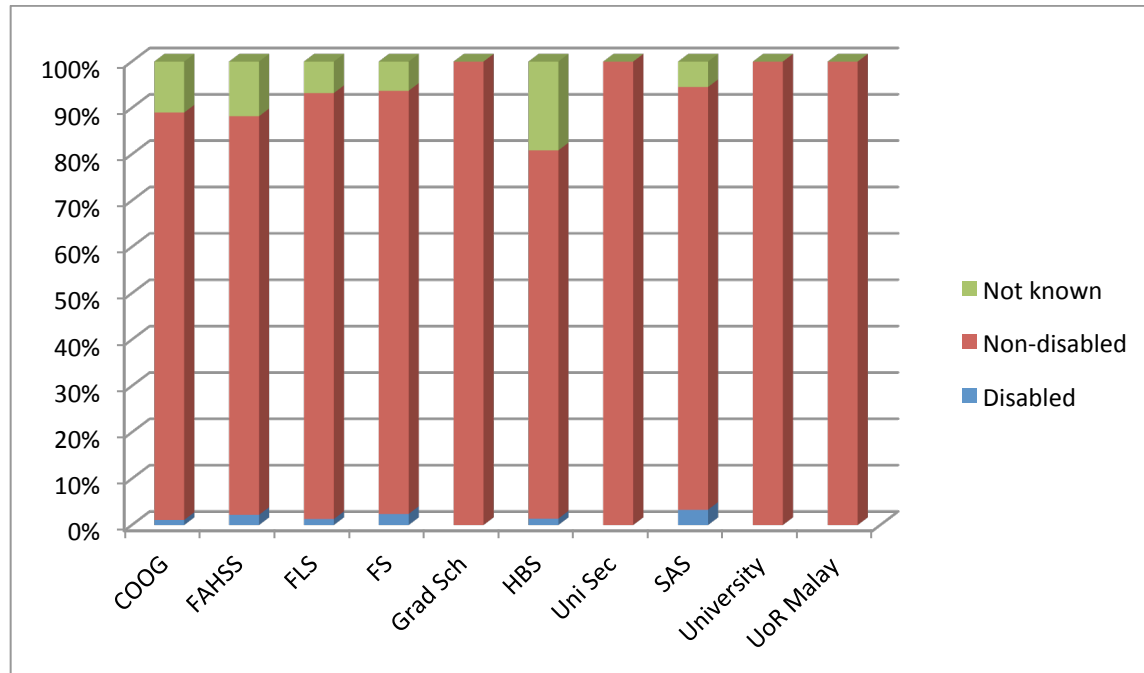
Amongst the academic staff there is a greater density of BAME staff in Research (13%) than in Teaching and Research (10%) or Teaching Only (8.3%), but across all academic areas of focus, Black or Black British staff have very low levels of representation;

- **Research** staff are the most diverse and the only group where White British staff are not in the majority (51.30%). The next largest group is those from an Other White Background (28.13%), Chinese (3.13%), and Asian or Asian British - Indian (5.46%). Just 1.56% are Black or Black British;
- Amongst **Teaching and Research** staff the majority are White British (52.85%), followed by Other White Background (28.51%), Chinese (3.51%), and Asian or Asian British - Indian (2.41%). There is low representation amongst Black or Black British staff (0.6%);
- **Teaching only** staff are less diverse with a greater proportion of White British staff (63.74%), and fewer from an Other White Background (13.38%) and other ethnic groups, and with a higher proportion of “Not Known” (8.35%), and an even lower number of Black or Black British staff (0.29%); and
- Amongst the **Professoriate** there are just 14 BME professors. The greatest proportion are Chinese (2.19%) followed by Asian and British Asian - Indian (1.75%), and small numbers from Asian or Asian British - Pakistani, Other Asian Background, Other Ethnic Background, and Other Mixed Background (all 1.76%). There are no Black or Black British professors.



## Disability

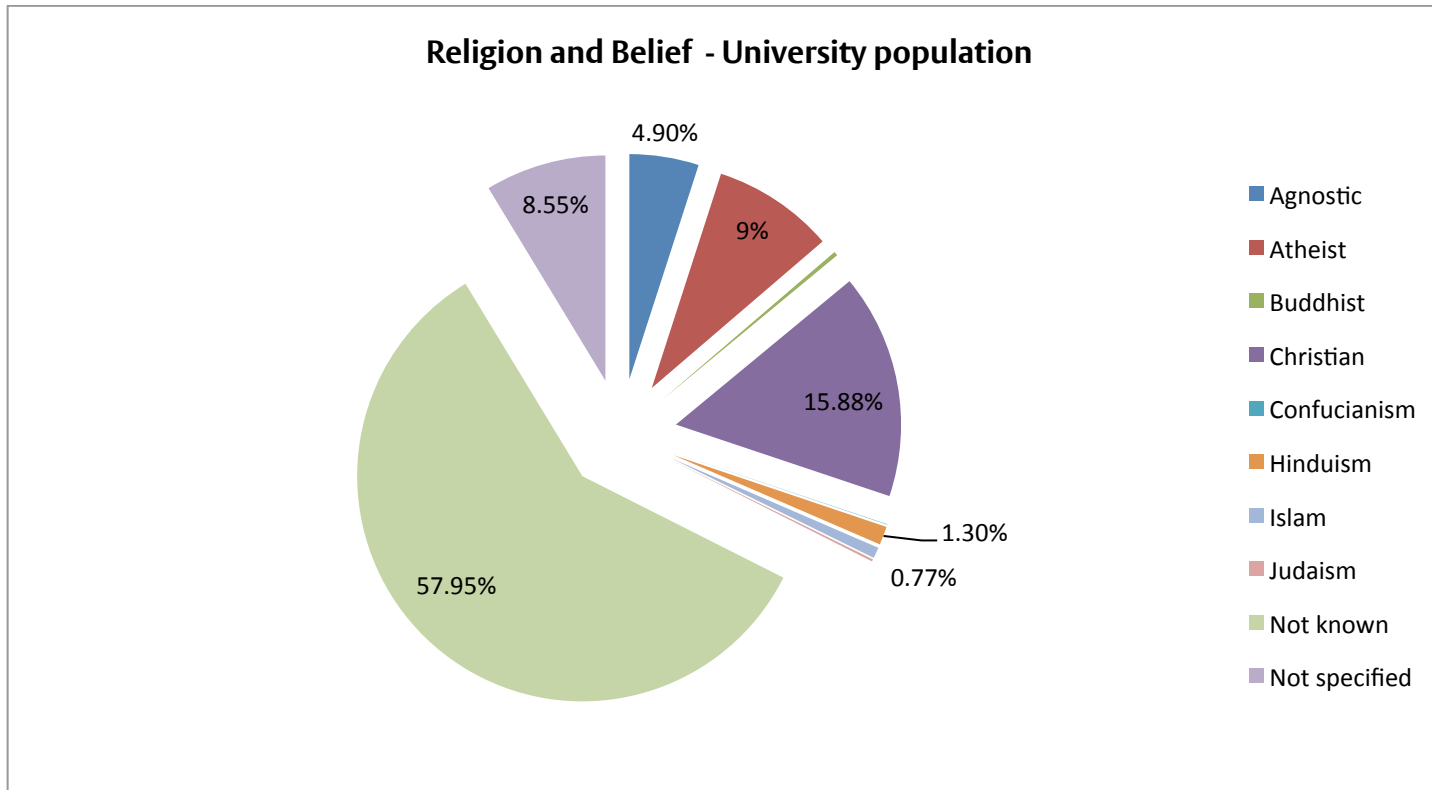
The numbers of staff declaring themselves disabled continues to be low across the University, however the area with the highest proportion has shifted to academic areas rather than the services. During 13/14 the highest proportion was in Faculty of Arts, Humanities and Social Sciences (18 people) followed by the Faculty of Science (14 people) then the Chief Operating Officers Group (12 people). This change may be down to the increased disclosure of personal circumstances for academic staff in relation to promotion and research activities. There are no notable variations by job family.



It is notable that there is a significantly higher proportion of 'not known' within the Henley Business School.

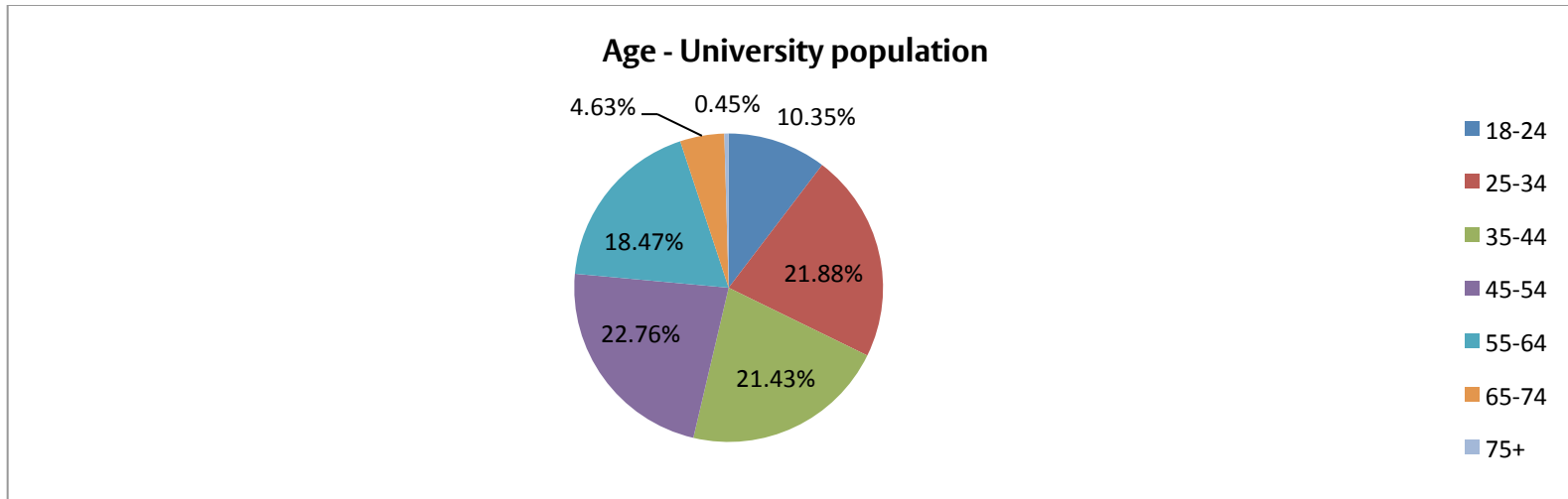
## Religion and Belief

Data on religion and belief was provided for the first time in 2012-13. A further 445 staff have declared this year, but the declaration rates still stand at around one third of staff. However, the rates are too small to provide analysis below a University level. Where the information is known, the largest proportion of staff are Christian (16%), followed by Atheist (8.6%), Agnostic (4.9%), Hinduism (1.3%), Islam (0.77%), Buddhist (0.29%), Sikhism (0.26%) and Judaism (0.16%). The proportion of staff where Religion and Belief is not known has dropped from 70.12% to 57.95%.

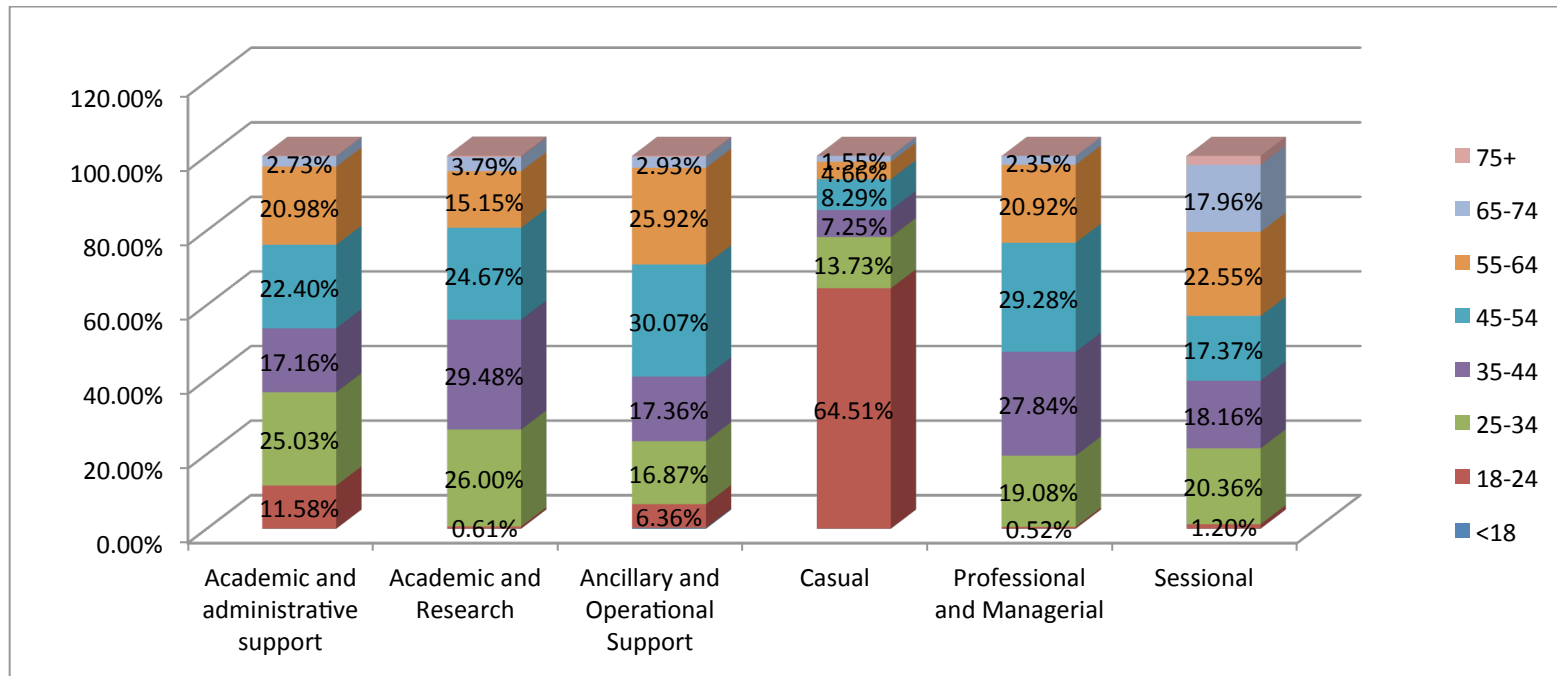


## Age

The University staff population is spread fairly and equally across those aged between 25-64 with around 22% in each category (25-34; 35-44; 45-54), with the largest proportion of staff aged between 45-54 (22.76%).

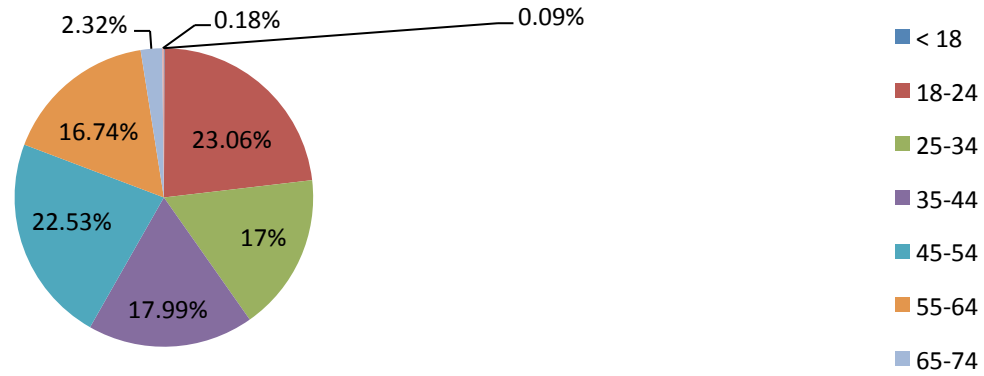


When viewed by job family it is clear that Casual staff are predominantly under the age of 24 (64.51%), and likely to be students or recent graduates. Previously Sessional staff were more likely to be over the age of 55, however in 13/14, although the highest proportion is still between 55-64 at 22.55%, there is a more equal distribution between 25-34; 35-44; 45-54 and 55-64. This may be indicative of the highly competitive market for academic roles, requiring more people across all age categories to consider more casual academic employment options.

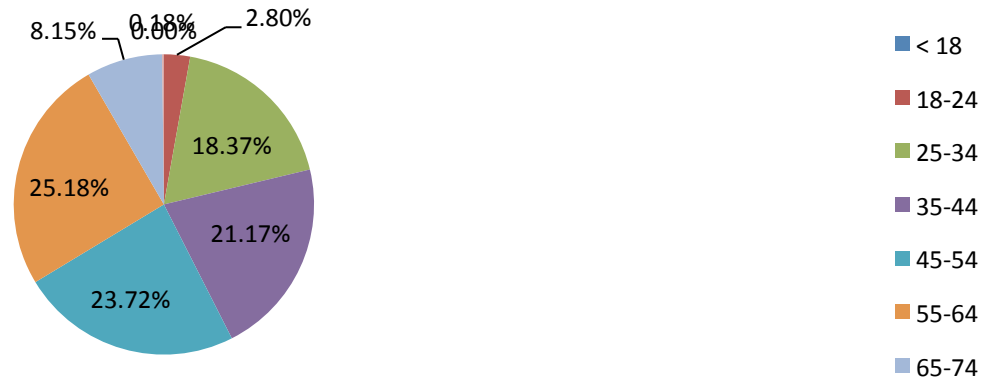


The Chief Operating Officer's Group has the youngest age profile with 23% of its staff under the age of 24, and 40% of the staff under the age of 34. Closely followed by Henley Business School with 11.87% of staff under the age of 24 and 35% of staff under the age of 34. Student and Academic Services has the next youngest age profile with 8.5% of staff under the age of 24 and 35% of staff under the age of 34. Conversely, the Faculty of Arts Humanities and Social Sciences has the oldest age profile with 57% of the staff over the age of 45.

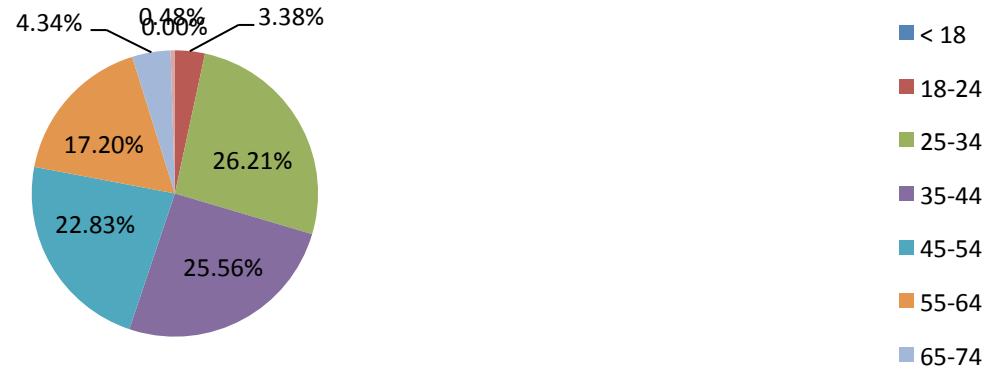
**Chief Operating Officers Group by Age**



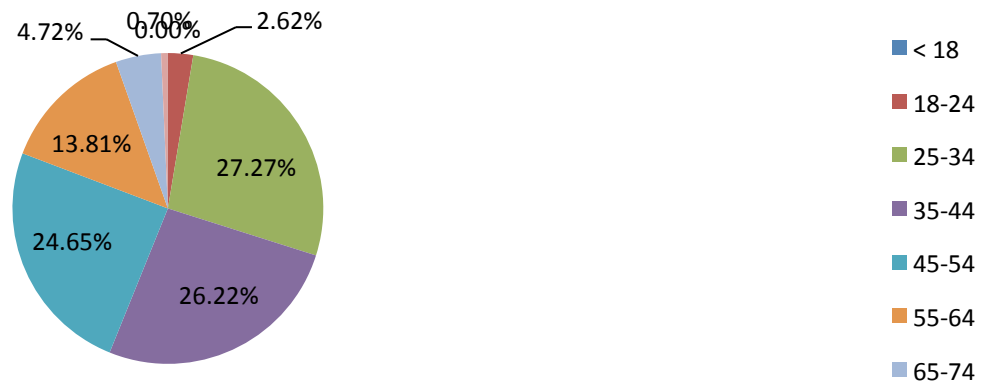
**Faculty of Arts, Humanities, and Social Sciences by Age**



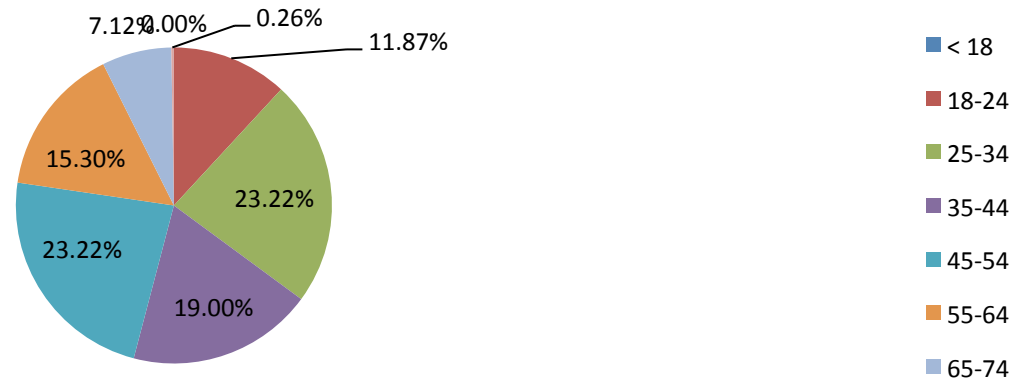
Faculty of Life Sciences by Age



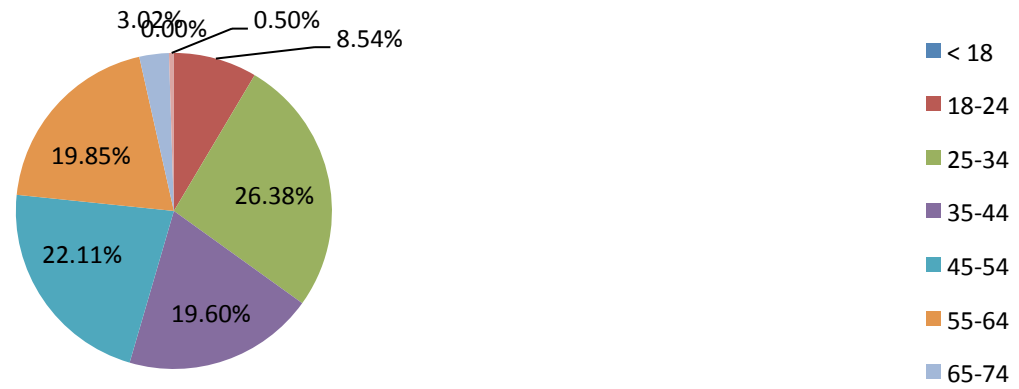
Faculty of Science by Age

The pay gap data shows a similar trend to 2012/13 where there are no significant pay gaps in grades 1-8. The overall University pay gap has risen slightly, although this reflects the distribution of women in roles rather than a comparison of equal value. There remain pay gaps in Grade 9 which in part relate to the structure of the pay zone. There has been a noticeable increase in the pay gap in Professorial



Zone 2 & 4. In Zone 2 there has been an increase in the number of Professors in this zone from 18-31 (were there more men appointed / promoted?). In Zone 4 the pay gap is as a result of the small numbers of individuals. However, the overall pay gap for senior staff has risen from 10.12 in 2012/13 to 25.38 in 2013/14.

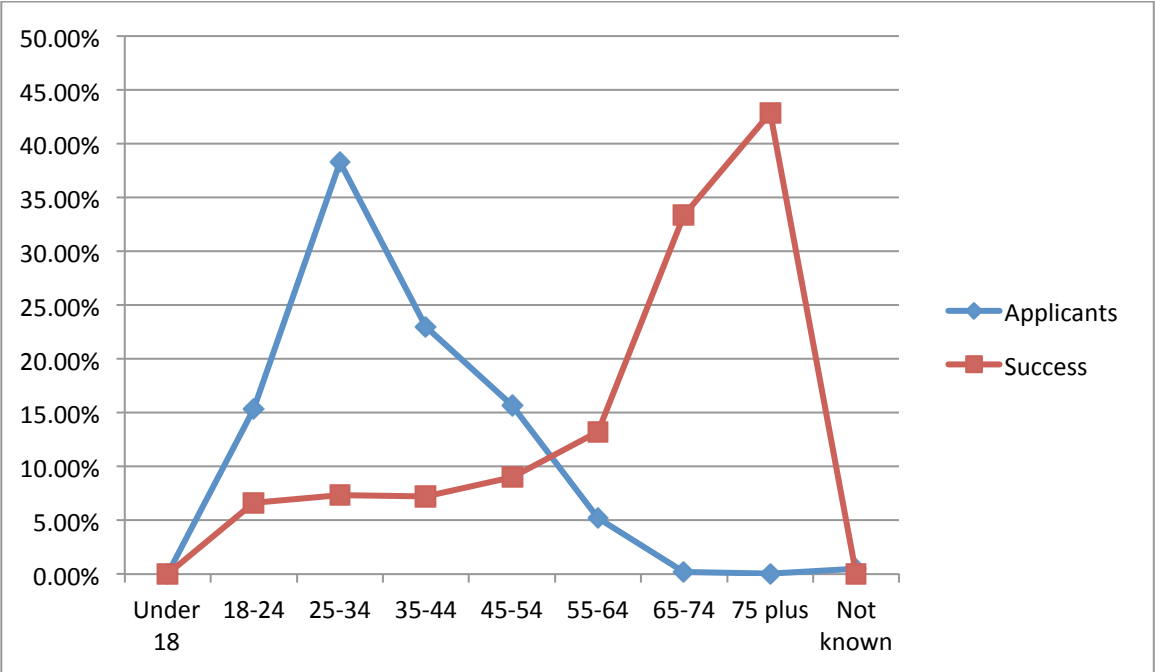

The pay gap data shows a similar trend to 2012/13 where there are no significant pay gaps in grades 1-8. The overall University pay gap has reduced slightly from 23.92 to 22.18, however it still reflects the distribution of BAME staff in more junior roles rather than a comparison of equal value. The pay gap at a professorial level reflects the small number of staff affected.
